A Plan for Prevention Funding and Reducing Alcohol Harms

Tracey Rattray is the executive director of the California Alliance for Prevention Funding.

She works with partners to advocate for the creation of a State Wellness Trust that will provide sustained, dedicated funding for chronic disease and injury prevention.

Proposed funding for the Trust will come from targeting substances that commonly create health problems in the first place – alcohol and sugary beverages. This proposed fund has the potential to reduce alcohol-related harms through a variety of best practices.
